Government of The Bahamas approves official designation of Ocean Cay MSC Marine Reserve

Ocean Cay designated a marine reserve in recognition of MSC Foundation's pioneering conservation initiatives. Ocean Cay assigned status of designated port of The Bahamas

Nasau, The Bahamas – 13 January 2020 – The Government of The Bahamas today informed MSC Foundation of its decision to confer the official designation of marine reserve on Ocean Cay and its surrounding seas, while simultaneously assigning Ocean Cay the status of Designated Port.

The decisions, notified through the Bahamas Investment Authority and the subject of consultations with the Office of the Attorney General, Ministry of Legal Affairs and Ministry of Agriculture and Marine Resources, recognise the immense conservation undertaking involved in converting the disused industrial sand excavation site into an ecological paradise island for MSC Cruises guests. Central to this recognition is that Ocean Cay is much more than a unique tourist destination, also having been created as a location to study and promote the protection and restoration of the marine environment, advance scientific understanding and educate visitors.

The MSC Foundation's coral restoration programme, pioneering the use of Super Coral in the surrounding ocean, and the associated Rapid Ecological Assessment were cited among the salient commitments recognised, as were the related #SuperCoralPlay public awareness initiatives and activities culminating in the Super Bowl LIV sports event on 2nd February.

The Ocean Cay MSC Marine Reserve Coral Restoration Programme sees the MSC Foundation partnering with a panel of conservation experts to restore and nurture the coral beds in 64 square miles of marine waters around Ocean Cay. The ecosystems here are populated by one of the most vulnerable sets of coral species on the planet, which face growing environmental pressures.

The speed of the Government of The Bahamas official designation of Ocean Cay as a marine reserve recognises both the value of the MSC Foundation's programmes and the urgency of the situations they address, with only 16% of the Caribbean's original coral reefs still surviving and predatory reef fish populations down 90% due to overfishing.

The strong partnerships formed between The Bahamas' authorities, the MSC Foundation and its panel of international scientific experts inspire hope that, together, we can build a brighter future.
